What to do next year for the autocross, must decide by the November Club meeting. It sounds like St. Louis Corvette Club will donate sanctions again next year. That means, they receive no funds from the event, occur no costs because of the events, and need not supply any workers, equipment, or supplies. (same deal as this year). We did 10 events this year, maximum allowed is 7 per day, each NCCC club has 7 sanctions (events) each year. So, most we could do is 14, if we did 7 on Sat. and 7 on Sunday. Most important thing right now is which weekend? I like the current weekend, which would be August 20-21st, 2011 that is our "grandfathered" weekend. Number of events could be decided later (by February 2011) I will 1st try to verify surrounding Regions plans on event dates to try to avoid conflicts.

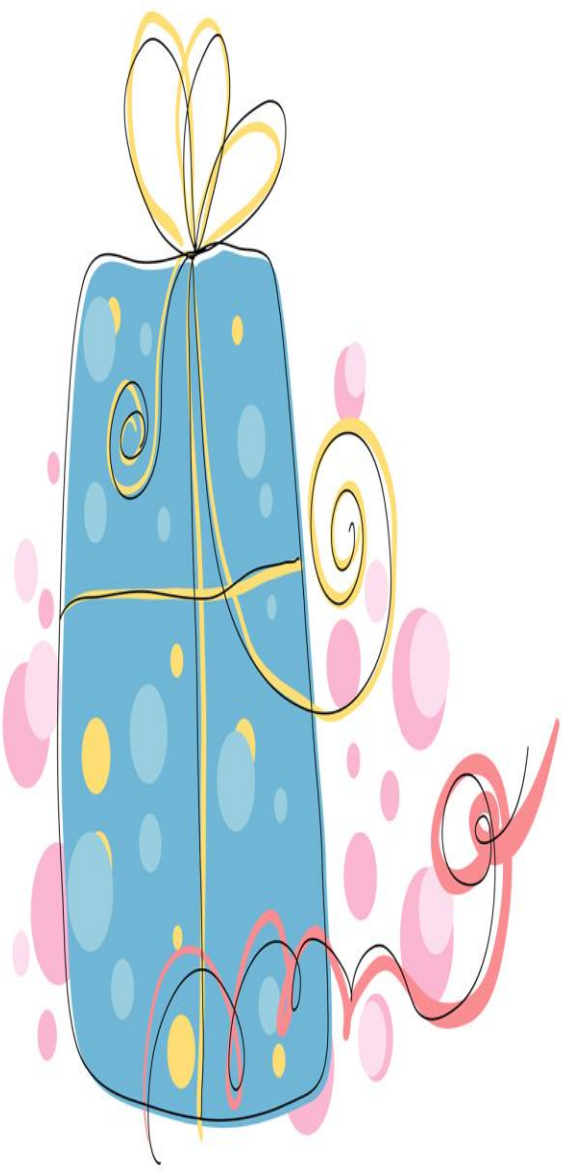
