

Joe Anelle began his report by stating that a box of tee shirts from last year's autocross will be selling at this year's event for \$5.00 for anyone interested.

Randy Moore announced that members wishing to attend the Hannibal Show, they will be leaving at 8:30 am from the QT at T R Hughes and I-70.

He also announced that on August 27, Boone Trail Club is holding a car show at Mid-Rivers Mall from 4-8 pm. Members wishing to meet up prior to attending the car show should contact Randy Moore for more information.

Randy stated that there will also be a car show at Edwardsville, Illinois, on Sunday, August 21. Registration will be from 8:30 to 1:00 pm and will cost \$15.

Joe Anelle announced that the website committee will on August 19th or 26th at his house at 7:00 pm. He will coordinate planning thru email. Anyone interested should contact Joe.

Bob Lamb announced that the Trailer Committee had finished its work.

Old Business

Tom asked for a volunteer to handle those arrangements and urged anyone interested to contact him.


There are also equipment needs for the weekend, a generator (Randy Jung volunteered to supply one), and weed eaters and leaf blowers (Bob Isermann and Sean Leary will bring those to Friday night's set up). Terry and Rod McCoy, Bob Isermann, and John Morak all volunteered to assist Tom with setup on Friday evening. Randy Jung asked if members could bring their trailers in and park them on Friday evening, and Tom said yes and explained parking. There is a flyer on the website with a map to the GM plant.

New Business

Sean Leary announced that the Board members had met prior to the membership meeting and discussed the financial breakdown for the members' expenses and the portion paid by the club. A motion was made by Rod McCoy that the members will pay \$25 per person for the party, and the club will pick up the balance of the expenses incurred. Chris Reitz seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

The party will be held the first Saturday in December and there will be no regular club meeting for that month.

Bob Isermann will be collecting for the Christmas Party as well as club dues during the October and November meetings. We will again be collecting toys for tots, and Bridget Balkenbush agreed to coordinate that activity. She will have more information at the next meeting.

NCCC STUFF



Route 66 Autocross

Our autocross is on schedule for August 13th and 14th. This is our biggest fundraiser for funds that stay in our club. Lots of help will be needed.

If you have seen the GM lot, you noticed it was full of new vans....They assure me it will be near empty by the 12th, any vans left will be consolidated inside what used to be barricaded with concrete jersey barriers, and anticipate less than 50 vans at that time. So, we may not be able to park in that area, we will have to see on "Game Day"



I have TWO sign-up sheets going around, 1 for Saturday, and 1 for Sunday. It lists the approximate time frame things work into, so you can easily sign up for 2 items. Most important is to have ample corner workers so we can switch out workers and everyone can get breaks. If you are only available one day, that is fine.

Anticipate being done by 5:00 pm on Saturday, and by 3:00 pm on Sunday. We will have canopies for shade at corner worker locations, and hopefully for the starter as well.

Planning on a “lunch break” on Saturday, but NOT on Sunday. You will still be able to get lunch; we will switch workers in and out as needed.

Trout’s are handling the food preparation and sales.

T-shirts have been printed and are ready, everyone who WORKS, or ENTERS the events for at least one day, will get a T-shirt as an award.

Workers must sign in at Registration (sign the waiver) to receive your T-shirt. Must be 18 years old, or have signed a “Parental Consent Form” waiver to be at the events. Sorry, no children can work on the course, as they must meet the same requirements as a driver.

Still looking for a place to have an informal get together on Saturday after the events are over. Last year we did it here, in the bar area. Open to all entrants, workers, and club members.....LOOKING FOR IDEA’S HERE! Anyone want to be in charge of this Saturday evening social get together????
