

Windshield Cleaning Tool

As the Route 66 Corvette Club Ambassador to the National Corvette Museum (NCM) in Bowling Green KY, I am privileged to see a lot of great techniques and tools to clean and maintain your Corvette. I know from personal experience that cleaning the inside of the front and rear glass is difficult to reach and to effectively clean that glass. Regardless of how it is done, it always seems to be difficult and typically requires a second try at cleaning.

At NCM, I observed people cleaning all the new Corvettes for NCM delivery. In particular, they used a triangular tool for cleaning inside of the windshield. After returning home, I purchased the Invisible Glass Reach and Clean Tool and Pad for cleaning glass. This is widely available at many local stores and online.

For me, this tool works very well, especially for reaching into the narrow area between the glass and dash. This tool with its pointed end can easily reach into the narrow corners. It is also has a flexible surface to conform to the curved glass.

Another very important cleaning hint was to limit the amount of cleaning solution. They recommended only one squirt for each square foot of glass. The use of excessive cleaning solution will saturation the cleaning rag or tool and that can lead to streaking. For best results, use vertical motions on lower sections of the window and horizontal motions on the upper sections.
