Technical & Trailer: Tom Reitz

The trailer storage location has been changed to Keeven Brothers Storage, 3023 Hwy 79, O'Fallon, MO 63366. It is paid for one full year from August 1, 2018 thru July 31, 2019 for a cost of \$385 plus a one time refundable security deposit of \$40, totaling \$425 We are located in spot #23 up against a fence and is 12ft by 25ft. We are on a waiting list for a different Keeven Brothers facility located in Old Town St. Peters, for same size spot, but it is paved and a little closer to town, cost is \$5.00 more per month, if a spot becomes available, we will take it and pay the pro-rated \$5.00 per month for the rest of our contract period. Gated entry code will be given to those needing access to the trailer.

Corner workers must be at least 18 years old but do not have to be a club member. They will receive a free T-shirt! Detta Nelson will need food works as well. Our location for this event offers indoor bathroom facilities in an air-conditioned building as well as a severe weather shelter.

Noel Wilson reminded us that Jack Schmitt has many other cars available at their other dealerships. Not just Chevrolet.


Announcements:

August 2, 2018 Meeting

For all the new people, these include all the National Committee meetings, the Regional Governors meeting, and the National Governors meeting, all over Friday evening and Saturday. AUTOCROSS

Our autocross is in ONLY 6 weeks from now. September 15th and 16th at the Family Arena. Flyer is on our website, as well as the Regional website and the National website. Last year we were short of workers for corners, I'd like to improve that this year so volunteers will be needed, even if it's only for a half of a day. I have a sign up sheet going around to help the autocross committee determine where help is needed.

The key persons are: Detta Nelson on Food, Chris Reitz on Registration, Brian Kleemeyer on Tech Inspection and Sean Leary will be in charge of corner working.

Governor's Report Continued

We should have 5 corner stations all with tents. You may drive a vehicle close to a corner if it's on the perimeter, park on the outer road and use you vehicle to come in for breaks. We need 2 people at each corner, with others swapping in and out as needed. We do have indoor restrooms again this year.

These events run rain or shine, we will stop in the event of lightning and we will have access to the lobby of the arena if lightning were to occur.

As of this point in time no other events are scheduled at the arena that weekend, so we will be able to leave everything set-up overnight, and campers and trailers can stay on the grounds Friday and Saturday nights. This could change, but is unlikely.

Route 66 Corvette Club:

Thank you for your generous support of our PAL PAX program. This past school year we were able to provide 54 children with weekly food packs. For many their breakfast and lunch needs are met at school Monday through Friday. PAL PAX seeks to take care of Saturday and Sunday. Each individual food pack provides 2 breakfasts, 2 lunches and 2 snacks.

The needs of these children are there sometimes through inadequate resources (*there is not enough to go around*) and sometimes through neglect. We realize that whatever the cause of the need, it is not the children's fault. We seek to meet a very real need in an encouraging, non-judgmental, discreet way. Thank you for helping us to do this.

Your support helps stretch our dollars for grocery items for PAL PAX. It cost about \$3.25 per child, per week, when we have to purchase all the items. With your support we look forward to possibly increasing the number of children we can serve.
