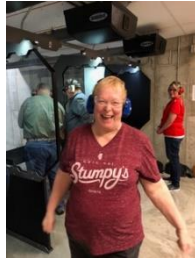

## **Website: Joe Anelle (Theresa Lindemann spoke in Joe's absence)**

Teresa has been taking new pictures of the Board Members to update on the website.

The waiver we need to use is now available on the website.

Joe and Teresa are going to organize a picture day to get pictures of our cars for the website.

## **Charity: Howard Sardis**

Howard has been investigating additional charities for our consideration and has come up with two.

1. Cross Roads Clinics - volunteers in medicine provide medical care and assistance for those without insurance and fall below 200% of the poverty level who have no medical coverage, no disability and fall within the ages of 18-64. Located in Lake St. Louis at the First Bank. They are a 501C3 and have 5 volunteer doctors, 5 LPNs and a couple of dentists. There is only 1 full time employee with low pay. The clinic is open on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9-1. [crossroadsclinicvim.org](http://crossroadsclinicvim.org).
2. Wings of Hope - Chesterfield. 85% of people cared for are children. This group is able to transport within a 600 mile radius. They are involved with 11 countries for humanitarian needs. They will provide transportation service to get the child where they need to go for care. There are times aircraft are donated to the group which they can either use for their purposes or fix them up and sell them to put the proceeds towards the work they do for the organization. They are a 501C3 -- 12 salaried full & part time staff and 200 volunteers. [Wingsofhope.ngo](http://Wingsofhope.ngo)

- With our 3 guests in attendance, the question came up about membership fees. \$85 per couple; \$60 for an individual.

## **Bylaws: Bob Lamb**

Discussed the second set of 4 changes:

- Modify the Standing Rules, Section 11.4 verbiage to state USO of Missouri is the permanent charity for the club (until the club votes otherwise).
- Modify the Constitution, Article XI, Section 2 verbiage that speaks to what happens to the funds of the Club should the Club disband. Currently the rules state the funds will go to the National Kidney Foundation. Change will make it the USO that receives the funds.
- Add verbiage to the Bylaws, Article 3 to indicate the annual dues to be paid by an Enthusiast member will be identical to the dues for an owner member.
- Name change for the Bylaws Committee. The new name will be “Rules and Regulations Committee”.
- Bob Isermann motioned to make the 4 changes as presented in Bob Lamb’s email to the club members of 2/21/18. Greg Fultz seconded the motion.
