2.6 Request for Quote: To be financially responsible with Club funds, competitive pricing/bids shall be obtained and documented when possible to substantiate desired Club purchases or sale of Club assets over \$500 in value. Exhibit C of the Club Standing Rules may be used as a guide for this purpose. It is mandatory that all bidders receive identical product specifications prior to preparing or modifying their bids. Once all bids are received for a Club purchase or sale, the Board of Directors will review and select a bid.

2.6 Request for Quote: To be financially responsible with Club funds, competitive pricing/bids shall be obtained and documented when possible to substantiate desired Club purchases or sale of Club assets over \$500 in value.
