We will be voting on the following new wording:





Article XI PROPERTY & FINANCE

Section 7. The Treasurer shall make and keep a record of property owned by the Club. This list shall be itemized, updated and published in the newsletter yearly. However, the annual inventory listing will not be placed on the Club web site.

Article XII BYLAWS

Section 1. Bylaws shall be established to supplement this Constitution and to provide for the effective operation of the club's activities.

Article XIII AMENDMENTS

Section 1. Motions to amend the Route 66 Corvette Club Constitution and/or Bylaws-shall be submitted to the Rules & Regulations Committee for their consideration and evaluation. Recommended changes to the Route 66 Corvette Club Constitution and/or Bylaws shall be presented to all voting members a minimum of one week prior to the voting meeting. Discussions on the recommended change(s) will be held prior to the voting process at the Club meeting.

Section 2. A simple majority vote of those voting member present shall be necessary for passage of amendments to this Constitution and/or Bylaws.

Section 3. Following a Club approval vote, the Rules & Regulations Committee shall make the necessary changes to the Club document(s) and disseminate the changes to the Club membership by providing the revised document to the webmaster.

A motion is made by Tom Reitz to accept the new constitutional wording as above. Seconded by Greg Fultz. No discussion.

- A reminder to anyone who competes in autocross. Check your helmets before the start of the season to ensure they are compliant. Helmets are good for only 10 years from date of manufacture, and must be SNELL rated "M" or "SA". "M" rating is for motorcycle, and "SA" is for special application. These are fire retardant inside and outside and have fireproof straps.


