A couple more things to remember:

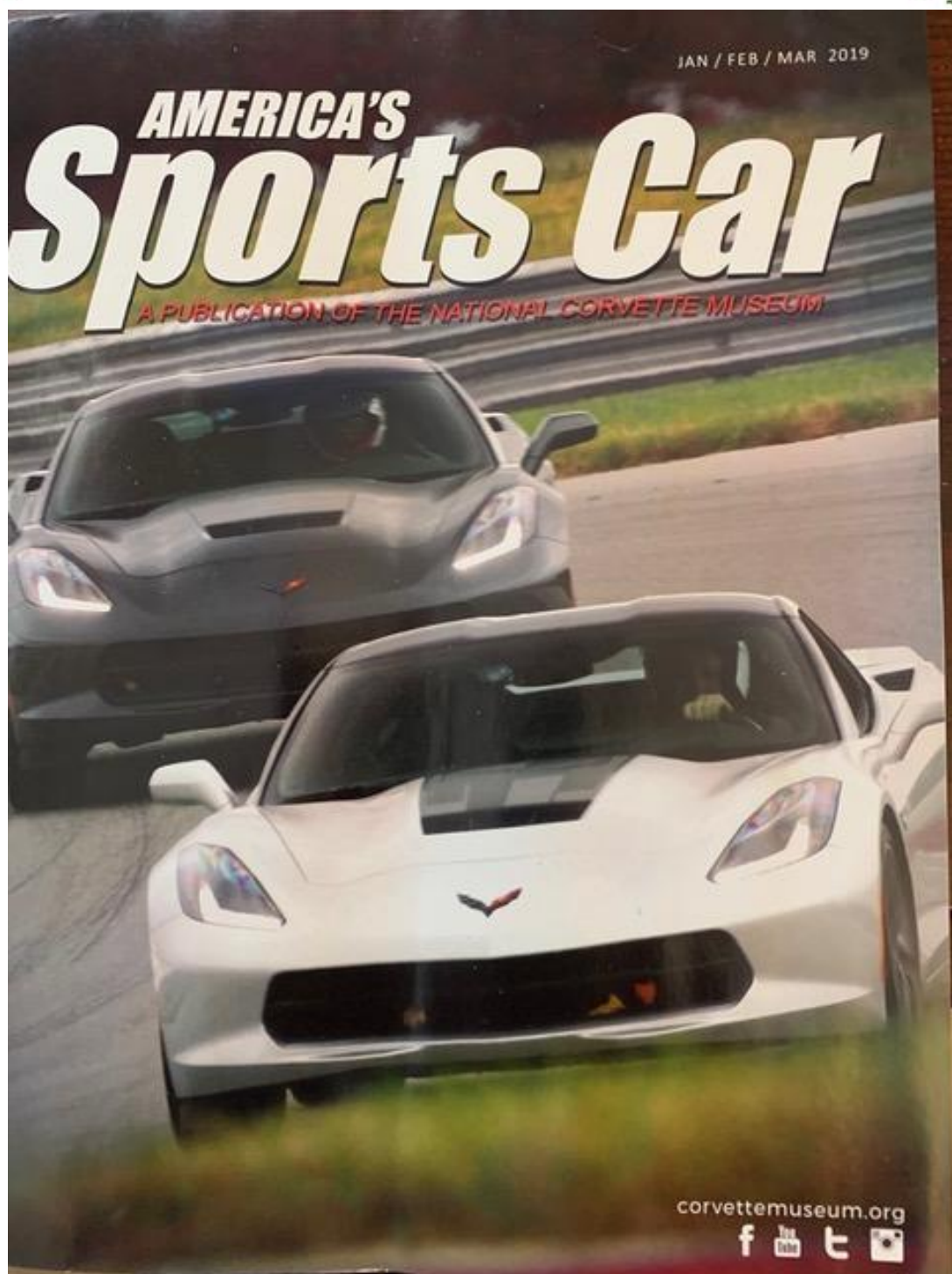
- ❖ Delta is having our social meeting on Wednesday, January 2nd, 5:30 pm at Madison's Cafe on Hwy K.
