These meetings are open to all NCCC members if you have any interest on how the National body operates and wish to see it firsthand.

NCCC has new insurance requirements. Waivers are only required for competitive events and parades. Competitive events include autocross, rally's and car shows. For car shows only, entrants and workers must sign a waiver, not the general public. For parades, the driver and all passengers must sign a waiver. Waivers are NOT required for social events, such as meetings, birthday bashes, winery runs, Rascal's games, club picnic's, and the like. These events must be published and open to all members. Published means the event must be in meeting minutes and/or posted on the social website (Facebook) club page. Impromptu events and spontaneous gatherings are not covered under any circumstances.


