AUTOCROSS

We are On Pace, but still need lots of help on the days of the events, June 29th and 30th. A flyer was in the April newsletter. I have Shelly Gracey bringing one gas powered blower to the track Friday afternoon to clean the track. If anyone else has a gas powered blower and time available on Friday about 3:30 to help blow off the track, it would be appreciated. I plan to be done and gone by 5:30 pm Friday afternoon (Barring an event at the arena that day).



Governor's Report Continued

Autocross is a rain or shine event. We do have indoor restrooms with A/C, and we will plan a location for dinner on Saturday evening for entrants and workers. All workers will receive an event T-shirt.

Workers typically need to be at the arena by 7:45 am and we intend to be fully completed by 4:00 pm on Saturday and 3:00 pm on Sunday. If you work, you may leave at any time (please notify someone if you are leaving). Partial day working is 100% O.K.

All workers, entrants, and spectators MUST sign the waiver. We have a specific waiver form for minors (under 18 years old) which must also be signed by ONE parent or legal guardian. Waivers will be either at the Registration table or at the food tent.

Please bring a two-way FRS radio if you intend to work. We use channel 6 (no sub-channel) for on course and staging activities. The club has about a dozen loaner radio's if you do not have one.

This is an important event for our club. It raises money that is used for club operations and is not earmarked for any charitable donation.


