Governor's Report

July 2020

NCCC STUFF

- Up-coming events: basically everything is cancelled, some events may go on but it's going to be hit or miss. Indiana Region and the West Region are still doing events this year, please check the National website competition page for schedules and flyers.
- NO "national" competition points to be awarded for the year 2020, Regions can do their own points awards if they wish. The Midwest Region has decided to not do competition points awards for 2020 and a Regional Party to celebrate the 2020 competition year is unlikely.
- Proposed rulebook change for 2022 would reduce the maximum number of events per day from 7 to 5, thus making 14 event weekends into 10 event weekends. This would be nationwide, and probably have little or no effect on attendance. It may reduce revenue slightly, but would also reduce the time needed to be working at the events, which as many of you know can sometimes be a long day.
- For 2021 we have our own Russ Tharp running for re-election as Regional Treasurer, (1 year term), and Chris Reitz seeking re-election as National Treasurer, (2 year term). Thank you both for your service to the National Council of Corvette Clubs.

AUTOCROSS

- This year the autocross scheduled for June 27-28th was cancelled. Plans are for us are to do a practice ½ day on October 3, 2020 at the St. Charles County Airport. This will be strictly to figure out course layouts that function well and safely on the area we are permitted to run, parking issues, staging, corner worker station locations, and other issues we encounter. This "event" is not sanctioned, no points, no timing, all safety rules apply (helmets, signed waivers, car tech inspected) and will offer an opportunity for any club members to try an autocross at a true low speed event. The site is new to us, and autocross is new to them so we need to be safe and responsible adults. If it all works out, we will be very well prepared for hosting an NCCC sanctioned event at the site in 2021. Will need club approval for the expenditure of \$250 to rent the facility for October 3rd.
