## NCCC STUFF

  - Regions can do their own points awards if they wish.
- The NCCC convention in Indianapolis scheduled for July 6<sup>th</sup> thru 10<sup>th</sup> has been cancelled

## AUTOCROSS

- This year the autocross scheduled for June 27-28<sup>th</sup> was cancelled. Plans are for us are to do a practice ½ day on October 3, 2020 at the St. Charles County Airport. This will be strictly to figure out course layouts that function well and safely on the area we are permitted to run, parking issues, staging, corner worker station locations, and other issues we encounter. This "event" is not sanctioned, no points, no timing, all safety rules apply (helmets, signed waivers, car tech inspected) and will offer an opportunity for any club members to try an autocross at a true low speed event. The site is new to us, and autocross is new to them so we need to be safe and responsible adults. If it all works out, we will be very well prepared for hosting an NCCC sanctioned event at the site in 2021. More info on this to follow in the coming months.
