

Governor's Report

March 5, 2020 Meeting



- Up-coming events:

- Chris R has tickets for sale for a set of Michelin tires. All proceeds go to the NCCC FCOA program. \$20/ticket; Only 200 tickets will be sold.
- Our own Russ Tharp did an excellent job at the Midwest Region Governor's meeting as Regional Treasurer, Thank You Russ, and our own Chris Reitz continues to do an excellent job as National NCCC Treasurer



This year we will have our autocross on the same weekend as last year, June 27-28.

The day after our last meeting, the Family Arena informed me that we could not use their facility until November 28th and 29th so we are not at the arena for 2020. I have worked a deal to try this year's autocross at the St. Charles County Airport. We have a great pricing structure, indoor restrooms, and can still prepare and sell food as we normally do. The site has a huge deck right near starting line for viewing / food area / restrooms. Indoors is air conditioned with the air conditioning actually turned on! The course will be shorter, have lower speeds, and will require only 3 corner worker stations (instead of 6). The Airport Director is excited to work with us on this. Keep in mind, this is a "test" or trial run. So if we do well and the airport is happy, we would be able to return. If we screw up and have problems the test may be ended.

The club approved the budget for the autocross at the February meeting, but with a change in venue I believe we need a motion to change the location from the Family Arena to the St. Charles County Airport. Only difference is the price of the facility rental drops from \$3,200 to \$1,000 for the year 2020. [see minutes for motion]


