Governor's Report

May 2020

NCCC STUFF

- Up-coming events:
 - o May 30-31st, 8 HIGH speed events at Putnam Park, IN
 - o June 6-7th, 14 events at Grissom AFB in Peru, IN
- Many events have been cancelled, please check the NCCC National Competition database for event status.
- No competition points to be awarded until after July 1st (subject to change)
- No decision has been made yet on the NCCC convention in Indianapolis, whether to cancel or not. So for now it is still "ON" July 6th thru 10th

AUTOCROSS

The NCCC Regional Competition Directors met Friday night, May 1st and the Midwest Region Governors meeting was May 2nd. Two very important points:

- The people that do our timing will not do any timing until this passes, Dales wife Carolyn is in one of those extreme high risk groups, and those are the people who do our timing.
- NCCC will not allow points earning events prior to July 1st, that date "may" be moved later into the year.
 - With those two pieces of the puzzle their is no way we could pull an event off and have any success. The racing is merely a "hobby" and not a necessity, therefor, it has been decided not to do something that could possibly put people at risk.
 - NCCC will be putting some policies in place for events that do happen later in the year. This will include social distancing rules, availability of hand sanitizer, boxed lunches only, regular cleaning and sanitizing of restroom facilities throughout the day, no timing boards to be posted, etc.

Even if we could execute our autocross, all these rules would make it difficult to attract enough participants to turn a profit and everyone having a good time as well.

It's just not worth it and need to cancel for 2020. Feel free to ask any questions, but we can't even put this to a vote, it simply is not going to be possible.


