- Trailer Update:
 - The trailer inventory was conducted October 3, 2020. The contents insurance was approved at the October meeting and has been purchased for an annual cost of \$157 for \$7,000 replacement cost coverage. The insurance took effect October 28, 2020.
 - In the future, I expect to ask for some maintenance updates to the trailer which is now 11 years old. At a minimum we need to have a spare tire and wheel. If we do not replace all 4 tires, we will keep the best one for a spare on a new wheel. Tires are showing signs of dry rot and D.O.T. recommends tires only be used for 6 years from date of manufacture. I will get pricing and options sometime next year.





AUTOCROSS


