- Howard introduced Mandy Pratt, Director of Development (fund raising) of the USO
 - She spoke about the great things the USO does for our troops.
 - o The USO was only closed for 2 weeks.
 - Since that time there have always been volunteers on hand making care packages for the military.
 - They eventually were able to open at limited capacity and still are restricted now by St. Louis County.
 - O Usually, the St. Louis branch at Lambert serves 70,000 visitors.
 - 2020 was down to 35,000. (still impressive).
 - The Fort Leonard Wood location served snacks and beverages to quarantined soldiers.
 - The mobile USO unit a canteen of sorts is supporting other areas in military family programs.
- A donation check for \$1,000 was presented with photo taken
 - This amount is significantly lower as in years past do to club cancellations of activities early in the pandemic.
 - The USO will be in attendance at our Car Show in May and if available the unit may be there as well.
 - Route 66 Corvette club is considered Donor Status and is mentioned on one of the scrolling screens at the USO.

- We will have an American Legion Honor Guard representation
- We are in need of sponsorships
- Raffle tickets will be sold by Russ Tharp for the Cooler full of liquor.
