10 Important Corvette Records

Corvette History:

 Dave McLellan belongs to a select group by having been the second of only three Corvette Chief Engineers to date. He is also the very first Corvette Chief Engineer to sit down and write his view of the incredible story of America's foremost sports car. Published 2002. The book is available online and I can loan my copy to you.



Did You Know?? (from Chevy Corvette Trivia Book)

- In 2020, Corvette produced 20,368 vehicles, with 16,787 Stingray Coupes and 3,581 Stingray Convertibles. This is half of the original production order, primarily because of factory shutdown due to the COVID 19 pandomic. It is likely that this year of Covid 19 pandomic.
- the COVID-19 pandemic. It is likely that this year of Corvettes will be collectable in the future.
- Every Corvette until 1997 was made with other Chevrolet parts, not exclusively made with Corvette parts. 1997 was the first year that nearly every part was created for Corvettes, with the exception of the exterior door handles – those were the same as the Oldsmobile Aurora.
