NCCC Governor's Report: (cont.)

Craig presented charts supporting a discussion to discontinue club membership in NCCC. Here is a link to those slides: [A Look Into NCCC](#)

Key Points:

- We pay dues for about 210 members at a cost of \$5000 for the Club.
- We have about 10 members that attend competitive NCCC events, about \$24 per member.
- NCCC provides liability insurance for the club and Directors and Officers in that cost.
- We can get liability insurance and D&O insurance for about \$1300 per year independent of NCCC.
- Members that compete can join another club that is an NCCC member to continue to compete.

We will discuss this topic again next month. We must decide about it before starting membership renewals in October.

Car Show: Paul Kaus

The car show will be May 17th at Poage. Please sign up – only 18 have signed up so far. We are way behind last year. You must pre-register to get a shirt. Paul showed the proposed image of the shirt.

The sales of raffle tickets is at 370 tickets, \$3700. The prize is for a \$1500 gift card to Bass Pro Shop or Big Cedar Lodge. Proceeds go to the USO-Missouri and the Missouri's National Veterans Monument in Perryville. The majority will go to the far, but the remainder will go to Perryville. We will give the USO goods, not a check. That way we know what we gave them – no \$\$ taken from our donation by the national USO.

We have 6 sponsors so far and have raised \$2750 from them. Sponsorships are available at \$500 and \$250. \$500 sponsors get a larger logo on the shirt, are advertised at the show, get a link to their website from our website and are invited to come talk at a club meeting. \$250 sponsors will receive a logo on the T-shirt.

We really need more basket items to be raffled. The baskets earned \$3,000 last year and are a very important part of the fundraiser! Bring donations to a meeting. Patti will decorate the donations. Some ideas for donation applicable for baskets include margarita, Italian, hot wheels, lottery tickets, \$100 bills, etc. If you donate food, make sure that it is good till after May.

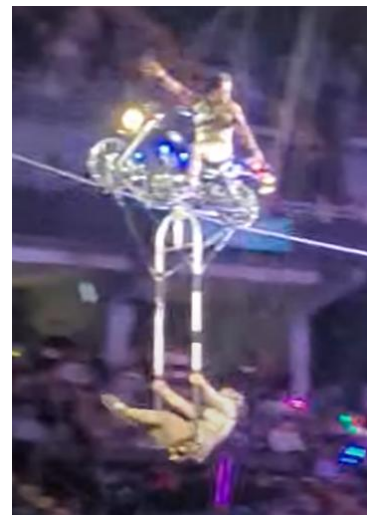

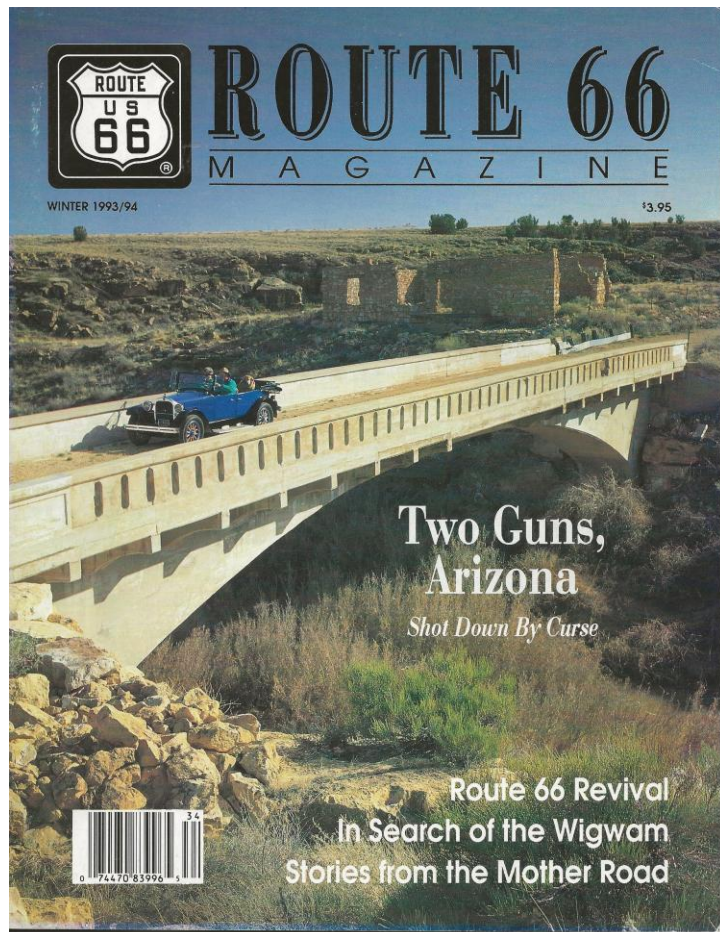
